- **Part C: Leading an Assessment Team**

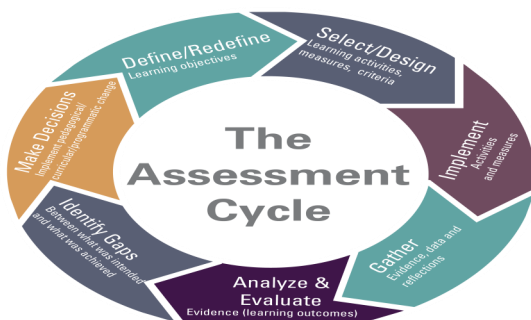
